- Successful completion of two semesters at an accredited college, university, or vocational school in the previous year.
- Must be enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational school for the 2014-2015 school year.

Joseph R. Beyrle Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility Guidelines

- Member in good standing of Port City Federal Credit Union
- Minimum grade point average of 2.50 or higher based on a 4.0 scale
- Have submitted a complete application for either a Port City Federal Credit Union "SmarTeen Scholarship" or "Advanced Scholarship"

All applicants must submit:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. High school or college transcript showing cumulative GPA
